Inspired by the epic voyages of the Vikings, our Scandinavian Golf Tour offers an unforgettable combination of world-class golf, Nordic culture, and breathtaking nature. The mystic Viking countries of Denmark, Norway and Sweden, along with Finland, will give you an exclusive golf journey that symbolizes an epic adventure, where you play some of the most impressive courses in the Nordic region and includes three nights above the Arctic Circle playing golf on Lofoten Links Island!

Day 01 June 12

The adventure begins when you arrive in Copenhagen, whose historic sites include the Tivoli Gardens, Little Mermaid statue, Amalienborg and Christiansborg Palaces, Rosenborg Castle, Frederik's Church, Børsen plus many museums. After arriving at your hotel, the Scandic Copenhagen, the remainder of your day is free to relax.

Day 02 June 13

This day will be free to get over the jet lag and to explore some of these many attractions.

Day 3 June 14

It is time to hit the golf course with a round at The Scandinavian, located about 25 min north of Copenhagen, and which is one of the few golf clubs in the world where they have two courses consistently ranked in the Top 50 of Top Courses in Continental Europe. The club provides golfers with a choice of 36 holes, designed by Robert Trent Jones II which are laid out in 200 hectares of forest separated by streams leading into natural ponds.

Day 4 June 15

Today, you will check out of your hotel and depart for the airport and the flight to Oslo. On arrival you will be met and transferred to the Radisson Blu Hotel Oslo. Oslo is known for its fantastic architecture, infamous Viking history, and outdoor activities so plenty to see and do in your free time.



Day 5 June 16

After breakfast it is back to the golf course, this time at the Miklagard Golf Club, an 18 hole, par 72 course designed by Robert Trent Jones II. The layout meticulously integrates the stunning Norwegian scenery and diverse topography. Miklagard is a championship course known for its thick rough and fast greens, but the design and different tee boxes thoughtfully considers all level golfers.

Day 6 June 17

Once more, you check out in the morning so to catch a flight north to the Lofoten Archipelago for a special experience at the Lofoten Links Lodge. The area is known for its dramatic arctic scenery, Viking history and colourful Norwegian villages but as for the golf, there are few places, if any, where a golfer gets tested against the elements as much as they do at Lofoten Links. Built into the rugged landscape, Lofoten Links combines its wild and wonderful surroundings with a world-class golf course.



Day 7 June 18

You will get to play 2 rounds on this spectacular 18-hole links course opened in the summer of 2015. The course is located by the seaside with an unobstructed view to the North and the midnight sun. Playing and walking the course is a grand experience and



poses a challenge to even the most seasoned of golfers. The Norwegian Sea provides its own water hazard on several holes, while its sandy beaches act as natural bunkers. This course is not for the faint of heart, but it is truly a rewarding experience and adventure not to be missed! The signature hole arrives early at the 140-metre 2nd, where the two-tiered green sits on a small rocky outcrop, fronted by a solitary pot bunker.

Day 8 June 19

In the morning, you will play your second round at Lofoten. Then in the afternoon, you will be taken on a tour to Henningsvær located 30 minutes east of Svolvær. Comprised of a number of islets spread among the waters of Vjestfjord, Henningsvær has the most well-preserved architecture of the traditional Norwegian villages, quirky cafes and restaurants, the Hus Gallery, and a burgeoning adventure scene. Henningsvær's dramatic setting is on par with the Reine, with colourful buildings lining the harbour and the steep mountains of Austvågøya as a backdrop.



Day 9 June 20

Time to leave this incredible area as you check out so to catch your flight to Bergen, located on the west coast of Norway in the heart of the fjords. As a UNESCO World Heritage City and a European City of Culture, the Bergen region has the ideal combination of nature, culture and exciting urban life all year around. On arrival you will check into the Home Hotel Bryggen, located in Bergen's old Hanseatic harbor area.

Day 10 June 21

You will not be golfing this day but instead embarking on the Flåmbanen, one of the best train journeys in the world, winding through some of the most dramatic fjord and mountain scenery in Norway. The journey goes through the steep and narrow Flåm valley, with views of mighty waterfalls, picturesque mountain farms and tall peaks. Afterwards, you return to town where you can enjoy the rest of the day in town.



Day 11 June 22

Today you check out and head to your next country as you catch the flight to Stockholm, one of the most handsome capitals in the world and which is built on 14 islands connected by 57 bridges. The beautiful buildings, the greenery, the fresh air and the proximity to the water are distinctive traits of this city. On arrival you will be transferred to the Radisson Collection Strand Hôtel.



Day 12 June 23

After breakfast, it is back to the golf course as you play the private Ullina Golf Club where, together with golf legend Jack Nicklaus, Sven Tumba has created one of Sweden's most beautiful and best golf courses. A design in perfect balance among softly shaped hills and ever-present streams. At least one enticing challenge characterizes each hole. From tee to green, your golfing skills are tested again and again.

Day 13 June 24

Your second round of golf in Stockholm will be at the BroHoff Slott (Castle Course). In 2012 the Stadium Course came of age when Lee Westwood conquered the Nordea Masters. But more significant for Bro Hof was the recognition gained amongst the Tour's stars who spoke passionately about the course and the fine level of detail put into creating a world class club. With long holes, large greens, considerable water, large and well-placed bunkers, not to mention the gusting winds, the Stadium Course is a unique challenge. The Course acts as a "lakeside path" around Lake Mälaren and suits all categories of golfers with a range of tees.



Day 14 June 25

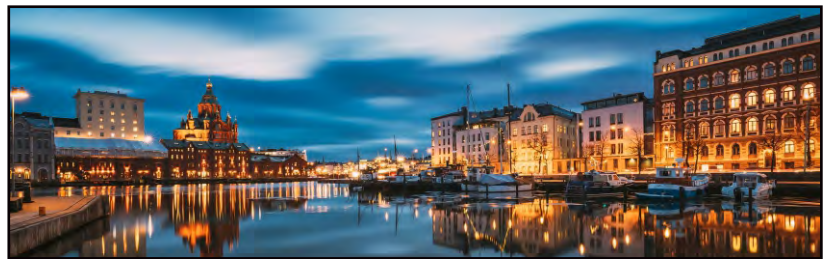
It has been a busy schedule till now, so today will be a free day to enjoy the many sights of the city.

Day 15 June 26

Your morning will be free but then it is time to check out of the hotel as you depart for your last port of call. However, instead of flying, you will be doing an overnight cruise to Helsinki!

Day 16 June 27

On arrival in the morning, you will be transferred to the Hotel Kämp with the remainder of the day free to explore the city. Helsinki has transformed into a vibrant cultural hub and is well-known for its innovative art, culture, and architecture. Attractions like the new Central Library Oodi, art museums such as Kiasma, Amos Rex, and Helsinki Art Museum (HAM), as well as concert and event venues like Musiikkitalo, Opera, and Finlandia Hall, are all located within a one-square-kilometre area.



Day 17 June 28

Today is free for you to enjoy more of the city or possibly enjoy an option round of golf.



Day 18 June 29

Your last round of golf for the trip will be at Kytaja, one of Finland's premier golf destinations. Awarded as the best golf course in Finland, the fairways and greens are surrounded by pristine lake and woodland scenery. The front nine plays across undulating ground and through delightful woodland. The back nine plays across flatter terrain with some holes hugging the shore of lake Kytaja where there are breathtaking panoramic views to savour.

Day 19 June 30

Your Nordic adventure has come to an end as you check out of your hotel one final time and depart for the airport and home (or your next onward adventure)!
