April 22 Day 1

Welcome to Malaga in the Costa Del Sol area of Spain. Transfers have been arranged for everyone so upon arrival at the Malaga Airport, you will be met by your driver and transferred to the SO Sotogrande Resort. Located at the westernmost point of the Costa del Sol in sunny, southern Spain, this resort is surrounded by legendary golf clubs so the perfect place to start this golf holiday.

The Costa del Sol receives on average 300 days of sunshine a year so you can expect moderate pleasant temperatures at this time of year.

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April 23 Day 2

Your first round of golf in the Costa del Sol will be at the Almenara Golf Club. Overlooking the Mediterranean and designed by British designer Dave Thomas, the club boasts 27 holes seamlessly integrating with the surrounding nature, adjacent to the Los Alcornocales Natural Park. Water plays a prominent role in its design, with two large lakes surrounded by cork oaks and olive trees, creating an unparalleled sense of serenity.



April 24 Day 3

Today you have a free day to relax or experience more of what the area has to offer. There are many optional tours to take advantage of with places like Gibraltar or, for those wanting something completely different, the Kasbahs of Morocco are only a short ferry ride away in Tangiers.

April 25 Day 4

You are back on the course today as you depart to play the La Reserva de Sotogrande golf course. Opened in 2003 and designed by the prestigious North American golf course designer Cabell B. Robinson, the 6,721-metre 18-hole par 72 course is a fantastic challenge for any golfer - both professionals and amateurs - thanks to its numerous tee options and imposing fast greens that allow for a

tee options and imposing, fast greens that allow for a wide variety of pin positions.

April 26 Day 5

Your last round in the Sotogrande area will be at Finca Cortesin, host of the 2023 Solheim Cup. Globally renowned for providing one of Europe's most unforgettable golf experiences and rated among Spain's best golf courses, including by Golf Digest magazine, the harmonious relationship between the natural Mediterranean landscape and environment on the resort's world-class 18-hole championship course make for a most attractive design.



April 27 Day 6

It is time to leave the resort of Sotogrande and take the short transfer to the town of Marbella. Considered unofficially as the capital of the western Costa del Sol, Marbella is known as one of Spain's premier tourist resorts. The town dates back to Roman times, a period from which abundant archaeological remains are to be found; two towers and the castle walls bear witness to the presence of the Arabs; and in the old centre of town, you will find numerous restaurants and shops. You will be staying at the five-star the El Fuerte. Situated on the beachfront of Marbella's city centre, it offers breathtaking sea-views along the promenade and across the Mediterranean and is just a five-minute walk from the Plaza de Los Naranjos in the Old Town. Your day is free to explore the town.

April 28 Day 7

After breakfast you head back to golf with your round today on the Marbella Club. Another Dave Thomas designed course situated amidst the hills of Benahavis, this magnificent golf course enjoys spectacular views of Gibraltar, the African Coastline, the Mediterranean and the surrounding mountains.



April 29 Day 8

The last round of golf in the Costa del Sol will be at the Flamingos Golf Course, which played host to the European Senior Tour in 2002, 2003 and 2004 as well as the Ladies European Tour in 2010. With undulating greens and enveloping views of the Mediterranean, it has become an epitome of big-time golf on the Costa del Sol. Pleasing any calibre of player, it is by far the best known golf course of Villa Padierna.

April 30 Day 9

For the last day in the area, we have organized a full day tour to nearby Ronda. Ancient Ronda is a colourful tapestry which make it one of the most interesting cities in all Andalusia. The landscape, the layout of the town, its history, the romantic legend of its bandits and the history of bullfighters and artists whose names have gone down in history: all makes Ronda a unique city. You will enjoy a walking tour of the old medina plus visit the famous bull fighting arena built entirely of stone in the 18th century. The day will also include a winery visit with a tasting and lunch.



May 01 Day 10

It is now time to leave the south and journey to Madrid by bullet train. The Spanish capital is a cultural and social wonder that attracts visitors from around the world and has something to tempt every traveler. With architectural wonders, world-class gastronomy, famed art museums and even an Egyptian temple within the city limits, you will not be bored. On arrival you will be transferred to the RIU Plaza Espana Hotel conveniently located in the center of Madrid.



May 02 Day 11

Today you will enjoy a ½ day walking tour of the city. The remainder of the day will be free to explore on your own.

May 03 Day 12

For the last day of the trip, you have one last round of golf, this time at the Santander Golf Club, a spectacular 18-hole course. Created by Grupo Santander and designed by Rees Jones, the course opened in 2005 and is considered one of the best courses in Europe. After golf, you return to the hotel to get ready for your farewell dinner and Flamenco show.



May 04 Day 13 Departure

The journey is now complete. You check out of your hotel and depart for the airport and the flight home. Your departure times from the hotel will vary depending on what flights you are booked on.
