January 10 - 23, 2026

Pack your clubs! Vietnam is one of Asia's best golf destinations, and its variety of top-notch courses will leave you amazed. Here you'll find a country bursting with energy and forward motion. You'll feel it in the hum and activity on the streets. You'll see it in the way Vietnamese welcome you to their homes, invite you to taste their food, and proudly show you their rich culture.

January 10

On arrival in Hanoi, you will be met and transferred to the 5 star Movenpick Hotel located in the heart of the 1,000-year-old capital city of Vietnam. Whether you want to experience the hustle and bustle of the myriad Old Quarter streets, the graceful charm of the storied French Quarter or while away the hours watching the world go by with a Vietnamese coffee in hand, you couldn't start in a better place. The afternoon will be free to relax before enjoying a welcome cocktail party this evening.

January 11

After breakfast you will be taken for a half day tour to explore Hanoi's illustrious history. Sites include the imposing marble edifice housing the Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum, One Pillar Pagoda and the first Vietnam University – the Temple of Literature founded over a thousand years ago. The remainder of the day will be free to explore the exciting area around your hotel.



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Over...

January 12

It is time today to enjoy your first round of golf in Vietnam which will be at the relatively new BRG Legend Course. The course opened in 2015 to become the first Jack Nicklaus designed course in Vietnam. The amazing beauty of the mountainous area of Soc Son combines with the unique concept of "twin greens", making for an enjoyable course to start the trip on.



January 13

You depart Hanoi today as you drive through rice paddy fields to Ha Long Bay. There you will board an Ambassador Signature boat for a cruise among the hundreds of islets of Ha Long Bay. Enjoy a seafood lunch and a stop on one of the islands before dropping anchor in the late evening for an overnight stay among the dramatic limestone peaks rising out of the sea.

January 14

You will enjoy a delightful morning cruise through the limestone cliffs and emerald waters of Ha Long Bay before finally returning to the dock. Then it is time to drive back to Hanoi and the airport where you catch a late afternoon flight to the city of Hue. Upon arrival you will be met and transferred to the luxurious Pilgrimage Village Resort.



January 15

Hue is a city chock-full of stories. The Kings of the Nguyen Dynasty built their feudal capital along Hue's fertile riverbanks and atop its forested hills, but their imperial legacy is just one of many reasons to visit. Hue's refined cuisine is the stuff of legend, and its leafy streets are lined with mossy pagodas, art déco mansions, and eye-popping markets. Through the whole scene flows the Perfume River, setting a languid pace the rest of the city is happy to follow. Today, you will get to experience the wonders of Hue with a half day tour that will take you to the Imperial Citadel and a boat ride on the Perfume River.

January 16

Now that you have had a few days to be acclimatized to the time zone and experienced many of the cultural sights Vietnam has to offer, it is time to get golfing. You will check out of your hotel today and take the short drive to Hoi An. However, enroute, you will stop and play a round of golf at the highly regarded Laguna Lang Co Golf Course. Ranked consistently in the top 5 courses of Vietnam, it nestles between a backdrop of undulating mountains and ocean views to provide a fantastic setting. After golf, you continue on to Hoi An where you will check into the Royal Hoi An M Gallery.



January 17

Hoi An was at one time a bustling trading port but now this World Heritage site is possibly Vietnam's most visited tourist destination. This is your base for the next couple days as you spend your morning golfing and then enjoying the quaintness of the Old Town with its shops and restaurants in your afternoon and evenings.

Today's round of golf will be at the Ba Na Hills Course, Luke Donald's first foray into golf course design. The course offers a total contrast to the Oceanside courses of the area as it is nestled into the side of the mountain range west of Hoi An. Ba Na Hills is also ranked in the top 10 courses in the country.



January 18

Today, you get a break from golf as you enjoy a free day to explore Hoi An. With its old-world architecture, cobbled streets, and distinctive yellow shop fronts festooned with colorful lanterns, it's no wonder Hoi An's considered one of the most beautiful places in all of Vietnam.

January 19

After breakfast it is back to the golf course. Today you will be playing at the Hoiana Shores Golf Club, the first Robert Trent Jones golf course in Vietnam. Just 8 kilometers south of Hoi An, this championship course is a links design with limited vegetation and rolling dunes and is fast becoming one of the favourite courses to play in the country. After your round is done today, you are free to enjoy one last night in Hoi An.



January 20

This morning you say goodbye to Hoi An as you depart to the nearby Da Nang Airport for your flight to Ho Chi Minh City or as many people still call it, Saigon. On arrival you will be met and transferred to the well located Mai House Hotel. After getting checked in, you will have an afternoon city tour that will include sites such as the former Presidential Palace, War Relic Museum and Binh Tay Market.

January 21

Today is your last round of golf as you depart after breakfast for the Tan Son Nhat Golf Club. This 36 hole course is located close by the airport. Significant earth mounding, many water hazards, large bunkers, and undulating greens characterize every hole.



January 22

Your last full day in Vietnam is open to do as you wish. It will be tough to decide between shopping for souvenirs or taking an optional tour to the famous Cu Chi Tunnels or out into the Mekong Delta. This evening we will gather as a group for one last cocktail hour and reflect on all you have seen in this incredible country.

January 23

After breakfast you will check out and depart to the Saigon airport based on your departure flight schedule
